The evening concluded with a VIP concert at The Ritz theater.

The purpose of the Benefit Concert was to support the ongoing tornado recovery efforts and contribute to community revitalization and emergency repair projects led by Rose Rock Habitat for Humanity. hroughout the concert, there were opportunities for information sharing, where attendees could learn more about the recovery efforts and hear stories of hope.

"We believe in the power of music to heal, inspire, and bring communities together," said April Grant, Community Engagement Coordinator with Rose Rock Habitat for Humanity. "Through this event, we aimed to support the Shawnee community in their recovery efforts, while reminding them that they are not alone. Together, we can create a brighter future."




